

Toy Hammock

Abbreviations:

ch - chain
sc - single crochet
dc - double crochet
sk - skip
sp - space
sl st - slip stitch
st(s) - stitch(es)

Materials:

150 yards worsted weight yarn, or the yarn of your choice.
6.5mm crochet hook

Gauge: Doesn't matter :)

Notes:

This pattern is written in American Terms.

When you're finished, the hammock may look really small to you - but trust me, it will s-t-r-e-t-c-h a lot once you start adding the toys!!!!

Pattern:

Ch 10. Sl st in 1st ch to form a loop.

Ch 111. (Or longer depending how big you want the hammock.) Sl st in 10th ch from hook. (This forms the second loop.)

Row 1: Chain 1. Dc in each chain across. (101 dc)

Row 2: Chain 5. Turn. Sk 3 dc, dc in next dc, *ch 3, sk next 3 dc, dc in next dc* across to the end.

Row 3 - end: Ch 1. Turn. Sc in first ch 3 sp. Ch 5. (Counts as dc and ch 3.) Dc in next ch 3 sp, *ch 3, dc in next ch 3 sp* ending in last ch 3 sp. (Be sure not to start working down the side of the hammock.) Work this row until you have only one ch 3 space left. Ch1. Turn. Sc in ch 3 sp. Ch 10. Sl st in ch 3 sp to form the last loop. Finish off and weave in ends. Hang in the corner of a room (I use the 3M hooks that stick on a wall) and enjoy not having stuffies all over the floor anymore!
