

Fill the world with flowers

These little flowers are great for using up scraps of yarn and they're so quick and easy to make it won't take you long to fill the world with dozens of flowers in all colors and sizes. I hope you enjoy the pattern.

Skill level

beginner



Materials

I've used a cotton fingering weight yarn (*Scheepjes Catona*) and a 2,5 mm hook. Feel free to experiment with different yarns and hook sizes.

Abbreviations = Standard US crochet terms:

ch = chain
slst = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
htr = half treble
tr = treble

Instructions

To begin: Ch 4, join with slst in first ch to make a ring.

Rnd 1. Ch 1 (= first sc), 9 sc in ring. Slst in first chain **or** join with invisible join into first sc (not the first ch). Fasten off. [10 sc]

Rnd 2. Join new color in any sc and work (ch 2, htr, tr) in that sc. (tr, htr, ch 2, slst) in next sc. *(slst, ch 2, htr, tr) in next sc, (tr, htr, ch 2, slst) in next sc*. Repeat *-* until you have 5 petals.

Fasten off and weave in ends.
