

# Granny Square Bucket Hat

## Materials

H8/5.00mm Hook

Worsted weight (size 4) yarn

MC (blue)- approx 87 yds

CC1 (white)- approx 21 yds

CC2 (red)- approx 31 yds

Yarn needle

## Gauge

After round 4, granny square should measure about 4.25"

Hat is made of 5 basic granny squares sewn into a circle, topped with another granny square and then the brim is added. It is one-size-fits-many with a finished circumference of approximately 22".



## Directions

Crown- make 5 granny squares

Round 1- with MC, all in magic ring, ch 3 (counts as a stitch here and throughout), 2 dc, ch 2, (3 dc, ch 2) 3 times, slst to beg ch 3. Fasten off. (12 dc, 4 ch-2 sp)

Round 2- Join CC1 in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp to make corner,

\*(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp. Rep from \* twice more. Join with sl st to top of ch-3. Fasten off. (24 dc, 4 ch-2 sp)

Round 3- Join CC2 in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp. \*Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next sp. (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp. Rep from \* twice more. Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next sp. Join with sl st to top of ch-3. Fasten off. (36 dc, 4 ch-2 sp)

Round 4- Join MC in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp. \*(Skip next 3 dc, 3 dc in next sp) twice. (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp. Rep from \* twice more. (Skip next 3 dc, 3 dc in next sp) twice. Join with sl st to top of ch-3. Fasten off, leaving a 12" tail for sewing. (48 dc, 4 ch-2 sp)

Stitch the 5 squares together into a long strip, then stitch the short ends together to form a circle with the right side facing out. Weave in ends.

Top of hat- make 1 granny square

Repeat rounds 1-4 of granny square, DO NOT fasten off.

Round 5- ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, 3 dc in ch-2 corner sp, \*dc in next 12 dc, 3 dc in ch-2 corner sp. Rep from \* twice more. Dc in last 9 dc. Join with sl st to top of ch-3. Do NOT fasten off. (60 dc)

Now attach the top of the hat to the crown by holding the wrong sides together and working a round of sc through both layers. This round will be on the outside of the hat at the top.

Ch 1, insert hook into same sp as join on the top of the hat and then into any dc on the crown, yo, and pull loop through both layers, yo and pull thru both loops on hook, 1 sc completed. Continue around only working into the dc stitches of the crown, skipping the ch-2 corner spaces. Fasten off. (60 sc)

Brim is worked in joined rounds

Round 1- Join MC to any dc on the bottom edge of the crown. Ch 1, work 1 sc in each dc and 1 sc in each ch-2 corner sp, join with sl st to first stitch. (70 sc)

Round 2- ch 1, hdc in same stitch as join, \*2 hdc in next st, 1 hdc in next st. Rep from \* to last st, 2 hdc in last st. Join with sl st. (105 hdc)

Round 3- ch 1, hdc in same stitch as join, hdc in each st around. Join with sl st. (105 hdc)

Round 4- repeat round 3.

Round 5- ch 1, sc in same stitch as join, sc in each st around. Fasten off. (105 sc)

Weave in ends.
